Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed

Local
Defence.
W. Ross attended the meeting and told the Council the present position with regard to local defence recruitment in the village and generally. After questions the Chairman thanked W. Ross for his explanatory talk and it was agreed to discuss the matter over and place it on the agenda for the next meeting.

Saving Committee
Representative
The Clerk reported on seeing Miss Bacon and obtaining from the Saving Committee the duties required of the local representative. Miss Bacon stated she was unable to undertake the duties of organising saving throughout the village and it was agreed that the matter be considered at the next meeting.

Saving Committee
The Clerk reported that the Rushmore Parish Council had suggested that representatives from the Parish Council in the Holtisfont County Council Division should meet with a view to agreeing a person to

nominate as a County Councillor. After discussion and explanation by the Chairman it was agreed no action be taken.

Correspondence

Hampshire Rural Industries: The Cllr read a letter from the Hampshire Council of Social Service. Mr Bobbold stated that he was in touch with the organisers and had given him the required information. The Cllr was directed to reply accordingly. Housing of old people. The Cllr read a letter from the Cllr Quay & Stockbridge R.D.C. with regard to special housing of old people. The Cllr was directed to reply that the Council considered this a good scheme but were quite unable to state how many old people would be prepared to take advantage of it.

Receipt of letter with regard to Bus Shelter. The Cllr was directed to reply that the Council did not desire to award themselves of this scheme as the Parish had a Voluntary Bus Shelter Scheme whereby a Shelter would be erected to accommodate the bus and no charge would fall on the rates.

Letter Soc. Receipt of letter from the Cllr to the R.D.C. that the Post Box at the Women's Institute had been authorised except that the Box had been erected.

Bus Service. Receipt of letter from the R.D.C. stating the Ant. & Dorset had made application to have their short period license made permanent and that no objection is

representation had been made with regard to this. The bld was directed to get in touch with the Kents and Dossat with regard to the times of certain buses.

The bld was directed to take up with the Divisional Surveyor the question of the repair of Church Lane etc.
