

Minutes of a Meeting of the Council  
held at the Social Club Braushfield  
on Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> November 1954

Minutes of the last meeting were  
read and confirmed.

Correspondence

The Clerk read a letter from  
the Arts and Dances Hotel Services  
with regard to suggested alterations  
in the time table. It was  
agreed to support the suggested  
alterations and the Clerk was directed  
to thank the company for their  
help and cooperation.

Receipt of a letter from the County  
Education Officer with regard  
to Braushfield Primary School.  
It was agreed that this matter  
be again placed on the Agenda  
for the February Meeting.

The Clerk reported that he had seen  
the Divisional Surveyor with regard  
to improving the line of road at  
Brown Hill & Kilm Lane, but it  
would not be possible to consider  
this improvement at present as it  
would entail the purchase of land

and that no money was available at the present time for this purpose

Baselton: It was agreed on the proposition of W. Greenwood seconded by W. Hobbold that application be made to the County Council on behalf of the Provisional Committee for the erection of a Bus Shelter.

Mr. Bacon produced a letter from George of the tenant of the old Council house in Hill View Road asking for hot water apparatus to be installed. After discussion it was agreed that such application be supported and the letter be sent to the Rural District Council.

It was agreed that the Devonshire Surveyor be asked to arrange for the removal of the heap and filling in the trench over in the road outside the door of Braehfield House.
