

Minutes of a meeting of the Council held
at the Social Club Bransfield on Monday
the 14th March 1957 at 8.30 pm

The Clerk reported that he had had an
interview with the Municipal Surveyor
with regard to the water on the road
between Orchard Lodge & Home Cottage
and in Kela Lane and the Surveyor
thought this was due to sponges in the
Road but that the matters were
under review.

The Clerk reported that he had been
in touch with the Traffic Superintendent
of the South Coast Bus Company who
stated that had not a representative
in the time table the desired alteration
in the Bus Service would have
taken place that day but now it would
not take place until the 14th March.
He had also taken up a question
reported to him by Messrs Bacon that
several persons who had taken
return tickets from Bransfield to
Southampton had to pay again on
boarding the Bus at Southampton.

The District Road Surveyor stated that with the approval of Mr. Hoddenott they were dumping all the surplus earth from the road widening scheme in the Village in the old sand Pit in order to avoid an ugly eyesore. It was agreed to support Mr. Hoddenott in his action.
