

Minutes of a meeting of the Journal held at the Social Club Braintreefield on Monday the 24th December 1957 at 8 PM

*Receipts* The Club reported receipt of letters with estimate for £12. 10. 0 for cutting the Recreation Ground hedge from Mr Boddle. This estimate was considered satisfactory and on the proposal of Mrs. Bacon seconded by Mr. Parsons it was agreed that the estimate be accepted.

The Club reported that he had again raised the question of the buses going to the road with the Traffic Superintendent of the Hants & Dorset District Service who had asked for more information.

The Club reported he had spoken to the Divisional Surveyor with reference to the offensive smell by the pond and it was believed that the drain by the side of Mr. Preston's garage under the Road was blocked. It was agreed to write to the Divisional Surveyor.

The condition of the footpath from Broadfield House to lower street was considered and on the production of Mr Bobbold secured by Mr Parsons it was agreed that the Revisional Surveyor to give his opinion

Mr. Brown reported on the application for planning permission for housing.

On the production of Mr Greenwood secured by Mr Parsons a Precept for £20-0-0 on the District Council was made and signed
