Minutes of the meeting of the Braishfield Parish Council held at the Womens' Institute Hall, Braishfield, on Monday, 8th June 1981, at 7.30 p.m.

17. MINUTES

Resolved that the minutes of the annual meeting, held on 11th May 1981, be approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

18. TVS 710/1 - TWO STOREY EXTENSION: ORCHARD COTTAGE, BRAISHFIELD - T. WOODLEY

Resolved that no objection be raised to this proposed development.

19. BOROUGH COUNCIL PLANNING COMMITTEE MINUTES

The Clerk submitted the minutes of meetings of the Planning and Development Committee held on 27th May 1981, and of the Southern Area Planning Sub-Committee, held on 12th May 1981, together with delegated decisions for the periods commencing 14th April and 12th May 1981, cleared by the District Planning Officer.

20. APPOINTMENT OF GOVERNORS - BRAISHFIELD COUNTY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Clerk submitted a letter dated 15th May 1981 from the Area Education Officer, inviting nominations from the Parish Council for its three representative Governors for the period 1st July 1981 to 30th June 1985.

Resolved that enquiries be made of the Parish Council's current representatives to establish whether they would be prepared to remain in office; and that the Chairman be advised of their wishes to enable him to arrange for consultations to take place with other possible candidates if necessary.

21. BRAISHFIELD VILLAGE HALL - GRANT

Resolved that the fifth instalment of grant, in the sum of £1,000 be paid, and that the sum of £1,000 be transferred from the Council's deposit account to the current account.

22. BRAISHFIELD CONSERVATION POLICY

The Council noted the content of a copy of a letter dated 3rd June, from Mr. A. P. Lalonde to the Chief Planning Officer.

23. HAMPSHIRE ASSOCIATION OF PARISH COUNCILS - ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Preliminary notice was received of this meeting which would take place on Saturday, 17th October 1981. Resolutions for inclusion on the agenda were to be received by the County Honorary Secretary before Monday, 31st August 1981.

24. CLERK'S SALARY AND EXPENSES

Resolved that the Clerk's salary in the sum of £50, together with expenses in the sum of £11.04 be paid.

25. ROYAL WEDDING 29TH JULY 1981

A letter, dated 29th May 1981, was submitted from the Borough Council giving information on a fund that had been opened to enable individuals and organisations to make contributions towards some "tangible expression to be made to mark this important occasion". It would be clearly stated that any gift provided was from the people of Test Valley.

Resolved that the content of the letter be noted.

26. HIGHWAY MATTER - PAYNES HAY ROAD

It was reported that the County Divisional Surveyor had arranged for soakaways to be provided in Paynes Hay Road and that these were proving to be most effective except for the one at Braishfield Lodge.

Resolved that the County Divisional Surveyor be thanked for providing these soakaways, but asked to give further attention to the one at Braishfield Lodge.

27. REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE

It was reported that no refuse collection had taken place in the week following the Spring Bank Holiday. Parishioners had, in accordance with normal practice, placed their receptacles outside of their premises. The parishioners were anxious to co-operate with the Borough Council, but it was felt that inadequate notice of collection arrangements was being given.

The Ward Member, Councillor Corry, agreed to take this matter up with the Environmental Health Officer.

28. BUS SERVICE

The Chairman undertook to arrange for a census of use of the Braishfield Bus Service to be undertaken.

29. BRAISHFIELD COUNTRY FAIR

Resolved that the congratulations of the Council be conveyed to the Country Fair Committee for its excellent organisation of this years event on 6th and 7th June.
