Lou Rhodes, Head at Braishfield Primary School, has confirmed that the School has no opinion on whether the thujas on the boundary of the school and recreation ground are removed; and she does not wish for their removal to be attributed to the school. Three quotations will be obtained for their removal (outside the nesting season).
