Copy of a report to be made to the Annual Parish Meeting to be held at the Women's Institute Braishfield on Monday the 23rd March 1964 at 8 p.M.

Mr. I. T. Robinson was elected Chairman and Mr. A. E. Cobbold Vice Chairman for the ensuing year.

All the members have been very regular in their attendance and Mr. Brown the County Council and District Council Representative has attended most of the Meetings of the Council and his help on many matters has been much appreciated.

Roads and Footpaths. Reports on the condition of the Roads and Footpaths in the Parish have been received and these have been referred to the Divisional Surveyor particularly with regard to the Corner at Broomhill and the sight line at Crookhill. The Broomhill Corner will be dealt with in the next year and the improvement at Crookhill will already have been noticed.

Recreation Ground The County Council has again made a payment of £ 10 for the use of the ground by the School for additional playing space and this money has been used to fence the Sandpit end of the ground.

The County Council during the year confirmed the inclusion of portion of the parish of Ampfield at Pucknall and a portion of Romsey Extra at Fairbourne Farm in the Parish.

A Speed limit for the Village was considered by the County Council but they would not recommend it for the Parish.

Many Planning Applications have been brought to the Notice of the Council and views express thereon particularly with regard to the planting of trees and shrubs at the new Petrol Station and the erection of new premises to house the Social Club.

The rateable Value of the Parish is £ 11,734 and the product of a 1d rate £ 50. 0. 0.
