It was with regret that Mr. Robinson felt obliged to resign as Chairman of the Council owing to commitments away from the District and that he may be leaving Braishfield. Mr. C.H. Bartlan was elected Chairman of the Council and Mr. Cobbold continued as Vice Chairman. Mr. H. Travis resigned on moving from the District and Mr. Steiner was elected to the Council.

Mr. Brown the County Council and District Council representative has attended the Meetings of the Council and his help and information he has been able to give was much appreciated.

Recreation Ground. After the site of the old Club Premises had been cleared it was not used as a Car Park has had been hoped it has therefore been agreed to fill in this part of the Recreation Ground and this is being done through the kindness of the Divisional Surveyor and will in due course form part of the playing space. The Ground continues to be used by the School and the County Council is continuing to contribute £ 25 per year.

Representatives of the Council has attended Meeting of the School Managers, Hampshire Parish Councils Association and the Local Association of Parish Councils

The Divisional Surveyor has been consulted on many matters and complaints and suggestions passed to him and the Council his grateful for his help. It is hoped that the Footpath through the Village northward from the School would be made in the year 1969/70 and that the land would be purchased in the coming year.
