Meeting of the Council had been regularly held and the members had been very regular in their attendance  
Mr. Brown the District Council and County Council representative had attended most of the Meetings and his cooperation and advice had been most helpful.

Recreation Ground. The old pit at the end of the Ground had now been filled and has been included in the Playing space. The entrance has had many loads of Gravel and it is hoped during the coming year to improve this entrance.

The Ground continues to be used by the School and the County Council contribute £ 25 per year to wards the upkeep of the Ground. but I must state that the cost of cutting the grass alone amounts to over £ 36 per annum

The Council is grateful to the Divisional Surveyor for his help during the past year

Many other matters had been discussed by the Council such as Housing Planning, Footpaths and Pillar Boxes I hoped dealt with to the satisfaction of those concerned.

The Rateable Value of the Parish is £ 15, 857 and the product of a 1d Rate £ 63. The area of the Parish is 2742 acres with an estimated population of 662
