

5. Matters Raised at the Annual Parish Meeting.

(i) The Council noted that concern was expressed about the unpaved yellow lines in the square. They decided not to proceed.

(ii) The Council decided to leave the H.C. in relation to the continual delay in finishing the road improvement, particularly in relation to the road facing reinstatement of enhanced double kerelkore holes, resetting the verges and grass cutting. The Clerk ~~is~~ was instructed to write and chase the authority up.

(iii) It was noted that no trees were to be planted ~~along~~ along the land between the War Memorial and the garage.

(iv) The Clerk was instructed to write to the Police in Rouley asking them to check on vehicles of a very heavy nature travelling and parking in the village.

(v) The Clerk was instructed to ask the T.V. S.C. to remove the dumped rubbish behind the old lavation, in the recreation ground.

(vi) The Council was unanimously against the suggestion that a Braisfield Man be purchased. The matter is to be dropped.

(vii) The Council decided to keep leaving the Southern Water Authority for main drainage.

(viii) The Clerk was instructed to write and thank Mr J.R.B. Brown for his very hard work on behalf of the Council.

(ix) The Council were not in favour of more Council Houses in the village.

(x) The Council decided that a football clubhouse should be abandoned. It was proposed by Mrs Bell and recorded by Miss Bacon that Mrs Fally should be nominated.
