Book Hill Hedge It was agreed that the Club should get

to get in touch with Mr Roddis

Relief Station The Club was decided to write to the  
Planning Office with regard to the  
planting of trees & shrubs at the Station  
as proposed

Hedge Reservations  
Ground The Club reported that the fence  
on the South West side of the Reservations  
Ground had been completed as agreed  
and it was agreed that the sum of  
£12 be paid to Mr R S Old. The Club  
also reported he had undertaken the  
work and the overground bushes

It was agreed to ask Mr. Bell to give a  
price to clear these bushes and erect  
a fence to complete the fencing of the field

Mr. Brown reported on the refuse collection  
which would continue fortnightly

That what was thought to be a bad hole by  
the old people Benjamins would be a lay by

That a planning application had been made for  
two houses on the site and the development  
committee were inspecting the site of Mr. Benjamin  
The club was decided to write to the Planning
